**Fees For Applicants For Pharmacist License And
Biennial License Renewal.**

- (1) The fee for licensure examination shall be \$300.00.
- (2) The fee for initial registration for licensure shall be \$100.00.
- (3) The fee for biennial renewal of a pharmacist license will be \$100.00. Upon verification of fifty (50) years of licensure in this state the renewal fee shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25).
- (4) All fees required above shall not be refundable.
- (5) Penalties for late renewal of a pharmacist license shall be governed by the provisions of the Alabama Pharmacy Practice Act.
