680-X-3-.02**Registration And Reregistration Fees.**

Fee amounts.

(a) Each Facility registration or reregistration for controlled substances, the registrant shall pay a fee of six hundred dollars (\$600) to be renewed every year.

(b) Each pharmacy registration or reregistration to dispense controlled substances listed in Schedule II through V, the registrant shall pay a fee of three hundred dollars (\$300) to be renewed in even-numbered years.

(c) Each pharmacist registration or reregistration to dispense controlled substances listed in Schedule II through V, the registrant shall pay a fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) to be renewed in even-numbered years. Upon verification of fifty ~~(50) years of licensure in this state the renewal fee shall be no more than twenty-five dollars (\$25)~~ (50) years of licensure in this state the renewal fee shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25).
