SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION:

Amend the rule pursuant to Act 2025-332 to remove requirement for volunteering at least 100 hours annually to qualify under the RSVP program. This amendment meets the "protection of public health" exemption from the moratorium on rule amendments contained in Governor Ivey's Executive Order No. 735, Reducing "Red Tape" on Citizens and Businesses.

540-X-3-.24 Certificate And Limited License Under Retired Senior Volunteer Program.

(1) (a) The State Board of Medical Examiners—may, at its discretion and subject to these rules, may issue a certificate of qualification in the Retired Senior Volunteer Program. The Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) is created for the purpose of permitting doctors of medicine and doctors of osteopathy who are fully retired from the active practice of medicine to obtain a limited license without cost which would permit the provision of outpatient health care services at established free clinics operated pursuant to the Volunteer Medical Professional Act, $\S 6-5-660$ 6-5-660, et seq.

(b) (2) Physicians having certificates issued under this section shall comply with the following requirements which are deemed to meet the requirements of Code of Ala. 1975, \$6-5-660, et seqmust limit their practice to the confines of an established free medical clinic, as that term is defined in Ala. Code § 6-5-662, or other non profit organizations or facilities located in Alabama which are approved by the board and which provide outpatient medical care for individuals unable to pay for the care.

1. Physicians receiving a certificate of qualification and license during the time period of January 1 through March 30 of any calendar year shall perform no fewer than 100 hours of voluntary service on or before December 31 of that calendar year;

2. Physicians receiving a certificate of qualification and license during the time period of April 1 through June 30 of any calendar year shall perform no fewer than 75 hours of voluntary service on or before December 31 of that calendar year;

3. Physicians receiving a certificate of qualification and license during the time period of July 1 through September 30 of any calendar year shall perform no fewer than 50 hours of voluntary service on or before December 31 of that calendar year;

4. Physicians receiving a certificate of qualification and license on or after October 1 of any calendar year shall perform no fewer than 25 hours of voluntary service on or before December 31 of that calendar year.

 $\frac{\text{(c)}}{\text{(3)}}$ Certificates issued under this section and licenses based thereon shall state on their faces that $\frac{\text{they}}{\text{the}}$

- <u>certificates</u> are issued under the RSVP and are subject to restrictions.
- (d) (4) Any physician inon whose behalf a certificate of qualification is issued under this section shall be subject to having his or her license suspended or revoked by the Medical Licensure Commission for the same causes or reasons and in the same manner as provided by law in the case of other physicians.
- (e) (5) Certificates of qualification issued under this section shall expire annually and physicians. Physicians may apply to the board for renewal of their certificate, but the board shall have full discretion to accept or reject the application for renewal.
- (2) (a) (6) A physician is eligible to receive a certificate of qualification issued under subsection (a) this rule if he meets the following qualifications are met:
- 1. (a) The applicant currently has or has had a full and unrestricted license to practice medicine in the State of Alabama or in any other state of the United States or the District of Columbia, which license is or was at the time of expiration unrestricted and in good standing with no pending disciplinary actions or investigations at the time of expiration.
- 2.(b) The applicant certifies, on a form prescribed by the board, that he <u>or she</u> is fully retired from the active practice of medicine.
- 3.(c) The applicant is in good health and is not currently undergoing treatment for a physical or mental condition which would impair the individual's ability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients.
- 4.(d) The applicant certifies, on a form prescribed by the board, that he or she intends to limit his or her medical practice to the provision of outpatient services at an established free medical clinic as that term is defined in Ala. Code 5 6-5-662 or such other nonprofit organization or facility that has been approved by the board and that furnishes outpatient medical care to patients unable to pay for it the care.
- 5.(e) The applicant certifies, on a form prescribed by the board, that his or her license to practice medicine in any state or the District of Columbia has never been revoked, suspended, placed on probation, or otherwise subject to disciplinary action and that the applicant has not had his or her hospital medical staff privileges revoked, suspended, curtailed, limited, or surrendered while under investigation.

6.(f) The applicant acknowledges, on a form prescribed by the board, that he or she is subject to the continuing medical education requirements for physicians as specified in Chapter 14 of the rules and regulations of the State Board of Medical Examiners.

7.(g) The applicant furnishes a certification of the employment arrangements or agreement with the qualified clinic or nonprofit organization.

(b) (h) A certificate of qualification issued under subsection (a) this rule shall be issued at no cost to the applicant.
