No digging on or near Archeological Sites.

The Historic Furnaces at Brierfield and Tannehill Parks and much of the surrounding property are recognized archeological sites. Both Parks include human burial sites of marked and unmarked graves. Much has occurred on these sites including conflict in The Civil War and arguably the earliest days of Alabama's Iron and Steel industry.

No digging or excavating outside of making firepits in the designated campground areas is ever allowed except for burials in cemeteries owned by the Parks or legally authorized archeological excavations approved by the Alabama Historic Ironworks Commission.

No person should destroy, disturb, deface, collect, or remove any natural, cultural, historical, archeological, geological, mineralogical objects or artifacts.

In the unlikely event that a guest, visitor, or employee should "find" something of interest please leave the object in place and notify The Superintendent's office as such items are the legal property of the State of Alabama.
