Pets are allowed conditionally such as dogs, cats, or other small domesticated animals provided they are under restrictive control at all times. Bringing saddle animals, pack and/or draft animals, livestock, such as pigs, goats, sheep, chickens, or cattle into a Park site that has not otherwise been approved or developed to accommodate them is prohibited.
