Establishing a New Program.

(1) A governing institution that plans to establish a new MAC education program shall submit to the Board a minimum of three (3) months in advance of the expected opening date:

(a) A letter of intent identifying the governing institution.

(b) A completed MAC education program application with supporting documents.

(c) The Board shall review the letter of intent, application, and supporting documentation for completeness and compliance with rules and regulations and may provide guidance regarding forward progress of the plan.

(2) A survey may be conducted to amplify, clarify, and verify information in the application.

(3) If all standards for approval are met, the program shall receive approval.
