School Equipment And Supplies.

(1) ~~Schools must provide a~~ Each school shall maintain a designated dispensing room which contains lavatory or area for the storage, preparation, issuance, and management of professional use products, supplies, tools, equipment, and chemicals used for student practical services and training. The dispensing area shall be equipped with a sink, bottles and containers distinctly and correctly labeled, a large wet sterilizer, adequate supplies properly labeled containers for all products and chemicals, an approved disinfecting unit, and a sufficient supply of clean towels, or linens.

(2) ~~Schools must~~ Each school shall provide a separate ~~room~~ area for demonstration ~~and study,~~ equipped with adequate visual appropriate teaching aids, chairs and adequate seating and/or desks workstations for ~~student use~~ students.

(3) ~~Schools must provide~~ Each school shall maintain a reference library ~~stocked with up to date books and materials recommended~~ containing current instructional materials and resources approved by the Board ~~for instruction. A. The library shall include a current~~ copy of the most recent version of Board's ~~law and regulations with any~~ laws and administrative rules, including all amendments ~~must also be included in library.~~

(4) ~~Schools~~ Each school must provide ~~a~~ an approved wet ~~sanitizer at~~ disinfecting unit readily accessible to each student work station.

(5) ~~Schools must provide adequate lockers for student use.~~

~~(6) School restroom may~~ Restroom facilities shall not be used for storage of supplies, equipment, or materials.

~~(7) Schools must provide~~ (6) Each school shall maintain adequate office equipment ~~for maintaining~~ and systems for the secure and adequate maintenance of student records.
