INDEPENDENT ADJUSTERS

482-1-151-.02-1 Lines Of Authority.

An independent adjuster may qualify for a license in one or more of the following lines of authority:

(a) Property and Casualty. As described in Code of Ala. 1975, §§27-5-5 and 27-5-6.

(b) Workers' compensation. As described for "workmen's compensation and employer's liability" in Code of Ala. 1975, §27-5-6(a) (3).

(c) Crop. As described in Code of Ala. 1975, §27-7-14.1(a) (10).
